**MINUTES OF THE 56<sup>th</sup> PERMANENT TRADE FACILITATION COMMITTEE**  
**MEETING HELD ON 22<sup>nd</sup> DECEMBER, 2015 AT 16:30 HRS** (30/12/15)

The 56<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Permanent Trade Facilitation Committee of the Pune Customs Commissionerate, was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Shri Vasa Seshagiri Rao, Commissioner, Customs, Pune.

The Chairman welcomed the members present in the meeting. The following points sponsored by the trade were discussed in the meeting.

**POINT 1. NON APPEARANCE OF SHIPPING BILL ON THE WEBSITE OF DGFT FOR CLAIMING EXPORT BENEFITS**

The Assistant Commissioner, EDI clarified that the DG Systems has informed to follow the following procedures for transmitting the Shipping Bills to the DGFT site in the following situations:

- (i) **Where the SB has not integrated with EGM (not in History) and is in EGM error queue** - The DG Systems has suggested that the exporters be guided to get their EGM error rectified and SB be moved to History after successful EGM integration. Unless it is integrated, SB would not be transmitted to DGFT for MEIS benefit.
- (ii) **Where the SB has Reward Item as "Y" and not visible in DGFT site** - it was suggested that the customs location may use "Retransmit SB" in Amend Role to retransmit the SB. Once successfully retransmitted, the DGFT website would reflect the same within 2 days. If the same is not reflected, the respective Customs location could write to Helpdesk.
- (iii) **Where the SB has Reward item as "N" and the same is not visible in DGFT site** - It was stated that in respect of SB date after 30.9.2015 the SB would not be sent to DGFT for MEIS benefit, as was decided between the two ministries. Further it was stated that in respect of SBs filed between 1.4.2015 to 30.9.2015 and EGM submitted successfully, such SB transmission to DGFT will be done directly by DG Systems.

The Chairman informed the representatives of the exporters to furnish a list of the Shipping Bills which are not being transmitted to the DGFT site to the respective jurisdictional Assistant Commissioner of ICD.

Commissioners have been directed to coordinate with Shri Javed of NIC to upload the said Shipping Bills. In case the Shipping Bills are not being reflected in the DGFT site, then in such a case to send a mail to DG Systems to resolve the issue at the earliest.

**(Action: AC EDI, All AC ICD's & PCHAA)**

**POINT 2. – COMMON AD CODE REGISTRATION FOR ALL PORTS**

The Chairman informed that the AD Code registration at the Ports is not a cumbersome procedure and the AD Code registration applications are being processed by the ICD officers without any delay. Moreover each Port has an independent status with specific location and with specific location code for easy correlation and identification among the Ports, and it's an EDI systems requirement, which needs to be followed as per the prescribed system policy. As such the request for one time AD Code registration with one Port to be used for all Ports cannot be considered.

**POINT 3. - AIR CARGO FACILITY AT PUNE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

In view of the long standing demand of the Trade & Industry, the matter was discussed at length and Shri Ajay Kumar, Director, Airport Authority of India, Pune, who assured the Chairman and the members that the process of transfer of the land from the Defence authorities have been completed and initially a covered space for handling 4 MT of incoming/outgoing international cargo with necessary facilities shall commence functioning from 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2016 onwards at the Pune International Airport. The Chairman informed the members that the Custodian of the cargo shall be the Airport Authority of India, Pune, and necessary Public Notice shall be issued in this regard.

**(Action: AC Airport & DC Tech-I)**

**POINT 4. - ASSISTANT DRUG CONTROL OFFICE AT PUNE**

The issue was already discussed in the CCFC meeting held on 01.05.2015. The Chairman informed the members that there is absolutely no inquiry from any exporters. Hence this issue cannot be considered at this point of time.

**(Point Closed)**

**POINT 5. - REQUIRE 2 IDs FOR EACH ICD**

The Chairman informed that the issue of allotment of two IDs to the data entry operators of the service provider M/s Xeam Ventures Pvt Ltd for each ICD's has been resolved. The Chairman directed the service provider to be very diligent and to be very cautious in feeding the data and that the importers/exporters shall not be charged for the data feeding errors by the service provider or by the custodian.

**(Point Closed)**

**POINT 6. - DELAY IN FILING OF EGMs BY THE CUSTODIAN / SERVICE PROVIDER**

The representatives of the exporters informed the Chairman that more than 2500 EGM's are pending for filing at ICD Dighi and the EGM's are pending for more than a year and that they are not able to avail any export benefits due to late filing of EGMS. The Chairman informed the representatives to immediately furnish a list of all pending EGM's to Assistant Commissioner ICD Dighi. The Chairman also directed the Assistant Commissioner ICD Dighi to correlate the number of EGM's pending to be filed by the service provider and the custodian and to verify the present status of the EGM's pending with the service provider and the custodian. The Chairman also directed the custodian and the service provider to take immediate action for filing of the EGM's and to report compliance. The Assistant Commissioner ICD Dighi to submit the action taken report in the matter. The Chairman also directed that representative of M/s Xeam Ventures Ltd, Pune, the service provider, be present for the next meeting without fail.

**(Action: AC ICD Dighi, M/s Dynamic Logistics & M/s Xeam Ventures Ltd)**

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks from the Chairman.
