**MINUTES OF THE 78th PERMANENT TRADE
FACILITATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 10th November
2022 AT 03.30 PM.**

The 78th Permanent Trade Facilitation Committee Meeting of the Pune Customs Commissionerate was held on 10/11/2022 at 03.30 P.M. under the Chairmanship of Shri Yashodhan Vange, Commissioner, Customs, Pune.

4. The Chairman welcomed all the PTFC members and departmental officers present in the meeting as well as those attending via Video Conferencing.

5. Shri Pratul Tiwary, Additonal Commissioner discussed the progress with regards to the points mentioned in previous PTFC meeting.

6. Circular No.11 of 2022 dated 29.07.2022

In Circular no.11 of 2022, Board has directed all the formations with ICDs, to examine the possibility of going for 24*7 clearance and take feedback from the trade regarding the same. So it was asked from trade members to give their views and opinions on 24*7 clearance from ICD in Pune Customs Commissionerate. Shri Pradeep Kale, PCHAA stated that the Trade representatives would discuss among themselves and submit their feedback shortly.

Action Taken :- (1) In this regard Shri Bhagwan Singh from Dolphin Company clarified the above point from PCHAA side as below :-

“As per views received from our members, we should continue with existing working hours at all ICDs. However as and when any Exporter/Importer/Custom Brokers require to clear an export or import shipment beyond the normal working hours, they should be permitted without charging any over time”.

(2) On consideration the above suggestion by PCHAA is accepted.

7. Shri Bhagwan Singh from Dolphin Company raised and sought clarification on the following points :-

Point No. 1.

EOU/STPI UNITS DEBONDING of Capital Goods.

- a) At present all the provisions of EOU/STPI units operating are covered under Notification No. 52/03-CUS dt. 31.03.2003, which has been amended from time to time.
- b) STPI unit is allowed to partially debond the capital goods and after working the depreciated value as per depreciation rates provided /Para 4 (a) /can pay duty but for exemption.
- c) The notification originally prescribed that “duty is payable on depreciated value or transaction value” which ever is more.
- d) However as per the notification amended vide notification No. 79/18 dt. 05.12.2018 Para 1©(i), it is stated duty on debonded goods will be charged “payment of duty but for exemption on the depreciated value”. The wording “transaction value for duty purposes has been omitted.
- e) However in case of goods which are more than 10 years old, and depreciation comes to 100%, Value become Zero and no duty is payable. We therefore request clarification for Capital Goods where depreciation value is NIL, if any duty is payable on the basis of transactional value, and if so applicable Customs Duty Notification be advised for reference and guidance of EOU/STPI Units 2.

Action Taken :- Trade was requested to present a live case to Jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner for proper redressal of issue

(Point Closed)

Point No. 2.

1. RoDtep Scrolls not getting generated. If the Rodtep gets stuck in Icegate there is no way that it can be moved. This is causing hardships for exporters in claiming the benefits of the scheme. If suitable guidance can be given on the same.
2. Registration of DSC on ICEGATE Exporters are unable to go ahead with submission of bank details for drawback or new AD code registration. It appears that the system is rejecting registrations on the basis of the DGFT and GST registered emails not being identical. The same error appearing even after correcting the email IDs on all portals i.e. ICEGATE, DGFT,


GST . This delays the exports and in certain cases the exporter has even had to forgo the drawback benefit.

Action Taken :- It was discussed by the Trade that certain ICD's are facing issue in generation of RoDtep Scrolls.

The trade was asked to submit exact details of such cases to the jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner/ Assistant Commissioner for redressal of issue. In respect of DSC registration they were asked to follow the required procedures set in the matter i.e. maintain single mail Id on Icegate, DGFT & CGST portals and if the problem still persists, to raise the issue with Icegate and share the Ticket Number with concerned formation for follow up action.

(Point Closed)
